- Both the Colleges shall be responsible for conducting the programmes till the end of the aforesaid programmes in the scheduled time in proper manner and in no matter left incomplete or harm the interests of the students and institutes.
- The implementation of each exchange program referred above will follow the guidelines established on mutual agreement by both the parties.
- Both the colleges will help each other in every aspect of the academic fraternity, but no financial commitment is required (for specific case if necessary, that will be implemented on mutual agreement by both the parties).

Nothing shall demise the full autonomy of either institution nor will any constraints be posed by either upon the other in carrying out the agreement.
