

### **Report on the One-Day Workshop on NEP 2020**

The workshop began at 11:30 AM with registration and a warm welcome. In the inaugural session, the Principal welcomed everyone, and the Convener from the Department of Education introduced the workshop. Dr. Anup Kumar Mandol delivered the inaugural speech.

Two technical sessions followed:

• Session 1: Dr. Mahfooz Alam, Assistant Professor at AMU Centre, Murshidabad, spoke on "NEP 2020 and the Future of Higher Education in India."



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• Session 2: Prof. (Dr.) Taraknath Pan presented on *"Redefining Learning Pathways for Career Success."* 

An interactive **Q&A session** allowed participants to raise questions and share their thoughts. The event ended with a **valedictory session**, certificate distribution, and a tea and networking session.

# Participation

- Total participants: 94
  - Student: 79
  - **Teachers:** 15
- The program was conducted in both **online and offline** modes to ensure wider participation.

# **Outcomes of the Workshop**

- The workshop helped participants understand the core ideas of NEP 2020 and its impact on future education.
- Many students became more aware of career options through interdisciplinary and skillbased learning.
- > 57 students' submitted feedback and most responses were positive.
- > Students mentioned that they **benefited** from the expert talks and discussions.
- > Many suggested that **more workshops like this** should be organized in the future.


